## What can I do? – Role play 1

You like Kishan and feel bad that he is often unhappy in the playground. You want to be his friend, but you don't want to miss out on playing tag with your other friends.

## What can I do? – Role play 2

Rose is your classmate and friend. She is kind and good fun and you often invite her to your house.

Recently, some of the other students in your class have been unkind to her. They refuse to play with her and sometimes don't want to sit near her in class. They call her names and say that she hasn't got a proper family because she has two mothers. She is often in tears because of the teasing.

Now some of your other friends have started to tease you because you are Rose's friend and you visit each other's homes. You really like Rose and want to remain friends with her, but you don't like being teased.

## What can I do? – Role play 3

Philip, who is in your class, suffers from eczema. This means that he often has a dry, red rash on much of his body, especially his hands. It is itchy and uncomfortable.

Often, Philip is not included in games and students complain if they are asked to hold hands with him. In the playground, when teachers can't hear, some students call him names and say that you'll get germs from him.

You know this is unkind and unfair.
